

Ecclesiastes 10:4

(NASU) If the ruler's temper rises against you, do not abandon your position, because composure allays great offenses.

(KJS) If the spirit of the ruler rise up against thee, leave not thy place; for yielding pacifieth great offences.

(NIV) If a ruler's anger rises against you, do not leave your post; calmness can lay great errors to rest.

(NKJV) If the spirit of the ruler rises against you, Do not leave your post; For conciliation pacifies great offenses.

(BBE) If the wrath of the ruler is against you, keep in your place; in him who keeps quiet even great sins may be overlooked.

(DBY) If the spirit of the ruler rise up against thee, leave not thy place; for quietness pacifieth great offences.

(ICB) Don't leave your job just because the ruler is angry with you. Remain calm. It will help correct your mistakes.

(NASB) If the ruler's temper rises against you, do not abandon your position, because composure allays great offenses.

(NRSV) If the anger of the ruler rises against you, do not leave your post, for calmness will undo great offenses.

(RSV) If the anger of the ruler rises against you, do not leave your place, for deference will make amends for great offenses.

(YLT) If the spirit of the ruler go up against thee, Thy place leave not, For yielding quieteth great sinners.

(AMP) If the temper of the ruler rises up against you , do not leave your place (or show a resisting spirit); for gentleness and calmness prevent or put a stop to great offenses.
