

Prayer of Agreement

Matthew 18:19-20 "Again I say to you that if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven. 20 "For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them."

Prayer of agreement is a partnership of two or more people in prayer employing prayer of faith, binding and loosing and prayer of intercession for others. In order for the prayer of agreement to work, the people involved in the prayer have to agree! If either of you get out of agreement it is nullified.

Principles:

- If is dependant on others being in agreement and faith with you.
- Heaven will back us up in what we pray on earth in agreement, as long as it in line with God's word.

Practical Exhortation:

1. Take it for what is says. If you are really off base you won't have peace.

He didn't say there is a possibility it would be done. He said it would be done!

2. Expect to get what you ask for

John 14:14 "If you ask anything in My name, I will do it.

3. Don't let the devil talk you out of what you agreed upon.

- God uses prayer for encouragement



Ecclesiastes 4:9-12 Two are better than one, Because they have a good reward for their labor. 10 For if they fall, one will lift up his companion. But woe to him who is alone when he falls, For he has no one to help him up. 11 Again, if two lie down together, they will keep warm; But how can one be warm alone? 12 Though one may be overpowered by another, two can withstand him. And a threefold cord is not quickly broken.

4. Husbands and wives have the opportunity to use this prayer

Amos 3:3 Can two walk together, unless they are agreed?



5. I try not to limit God to what I agree with others about "Above and beyond prayer"

Ephesians 3:20 Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us,

6. You can't change your mind later because you had a bad hair day.



Ask the right questions:

1. "What specifically do you want me to pray for?"

- You cannot know what someone else wants unless you ask.
- You must make sure you are in perfect agreement about what your prayer request is before you join with another-believer in the prayer of agreement.

2. "I am believing for _____ . Can you be in agreement and stand with me for this answer to prayer."

- By assuming you can limit your prayer

Power in unity:

Leviticus 26:8 Five of you shall chase a hundred, and a hundred of you shall put ten thousand to flight; your enemies shall fall by the sword before you.

Deuteronomy 32:30 How could one chase a thousand, And two put ten thousand to flight, Unless their Rock had sold them, And the Lord had surrendered them?



Greater potential power ~ Greater responsibility

Genesis 11:6 And the Lord said, "Indeed the people are one and they all have one language, and this is what they begin to do; now nothing that they propose to do will be withheld from them.

Synergy (Synergism) combined effort being greater than parts: the working together of two or more things, people, or organizations, especially when the result is greater than the sum of their individual effects or capabilities

Example: One Oxen can pull 2,000 lbs. Two oxen working separately would pull a total of 4,000 lbs. If you join the oxen together they can pull 10,000 lbs. Their combined forces produce a greater power and effect.
