

## Discipleship Ministry

Matthew 28:18-20 And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. 19 "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 "teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.

Vine's definition of Disciple: MATHÊTHÊS (maqthV) [Strong...3101], lit, a learner (from manthanô, to learn, from a root math-, indicating thought accompanied by endeavour), in contrast to didaskalos, a teacher; hence it denotes one who follows one's teaching.

### General Guidelines of Discipleship Meetings:

- Explain the importance of discipleship
- Agree upon a time to meet
- Make time together encouraging and easy
- Explain truths, give examples, ask questions, listen
- Do lessons in order of perceived need
- Have a time of prayer each session
- Avoid going too long (over an hour).
- Keep on track and to the point
