Bible examples where salvation included every member of the family

Pray these scriptures for your unsaved family members

NOAH - Genesis 7:1,7 ... Come into the ark, you and all your household, ... So Noah, with his sons, his wife, and his sons' wives, went into the ark because of the waters of the Hood.

LOT - Genesis 19:15 ... the angels urged Lot to hurry, saying, "Arise, take your wife and your two daughters who are here, lest you be consumed in the punishment of the city."

MEN OF ISRAEL - Exodus 12:3 ... every man shall take for himself a lamb, according to the house of his father, a lamb for a household.

RAHAB - Joshua 2:18 When we come into the land, you bind this line of scarlet cord in the window through which you let us down, and unless you bring your father, your mother, your brothers, and all your father's household to your own home. Joshua 6:23 And the young men ... brought out Rahab, her father, her mother, her brothers, and all that she had. So they brought out all her relatives and led them outside the camp of Israel.

ZACCHEUS - Luke 19:9 Today salvation has come to this house.

THE NOBLEMAN - John 4:53 ... And he himself believed, and his whole household.

CORNELIUS - Acts 10:24,44 Now Cornelius was waiting for them, and had called together his relatives and close friends ... While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who heard the word.

LYDIA - Acts 16:14, 15 Now a certain woman named Lydia ... worshiped God. The Lord opened her heart to heed the things spoken by Paul ... she and her household were baptized

CRISPUS - Acts 18:8 Then Crispus, the ruler of the synagogue, believed on the Lord with all his household.

STEPHANAS - 1 Corinthians 1:16 I also baptized the household of Stephanas.

PHILIPPIAN JAILER - Acts 16:31 Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household.

PROMISES - FOR INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS OF THE FAMILY

UNSAVED HUSBAND -1 Peter 3:1 Wives, likewise, be submissive to your own husbands, that even if some do not obey the word, they, without a word, may be won by the conduct of their wives, . . .

UNSAVED WIFE -1 Corinthians 7:12-16 But to the rest I, not the Lord, say: If any brother has a wife who does not believe, and she is willing to live with him, let him not divorce her. 13 And a woman who has a husband who does not believe, if he is willing to live with her, let her not divorce him. 14 For the unbelieving husband is sanctified by the wife, and the unbelieving wife is sanctified by the husband; otherwise your children would be unclean, but now they are holy. 15 But if the unbeliever departs, let him depart; a brother or a sister is not under bondage in such cases. But God has called us to peace. 16 For how do you know, O wife, whether you will save your husband? Or how do you know, O husband, whether you will save your wife?

UNSAVED CHILDREN - Isaiah 49:25 I will save your children.

CHILDREN AWAY FROM THE LORD - Jeremiah 31:16, 17 Thus says the Lord:

"Refrain your voice from weeping, And your eyes from tears; For your work shall be rewarded, says the *Ijord*, And they shall come back from the land of the enemy. 17 There is hope in your future, says the Lord, That your children shall come back to their own border.

Proverbs 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go. And when he is old he will not depart from it.

BLESSINGS FOR CHILDREN - Isaiah 54:13 All your children shall be taught by the Lord, And great shall be the peace of your children.

Psalms 115:14 May the Lord give you increase more and more, you and your children.

BLESSINGS FOR GRANDCHILDREN - Isaiah 59:21 "As for Me," says the Lord. "this is My covenant with them: My Spirit who is upon you, and My words which I have put in your mouth, shall not depart from your mouth, nor from the mouth of your descendants, nor from the mouth of your descendants' descendants," says the Lord, "from this time and forevermore."

Psalms 102:28 The children of Your servants will continue. And their descendants will be established before You."
