**Numbers 23:19 "God is not a man, that He should lie,
Nor a son of man, that He should repent.
Has He said, and will He not do?
Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?"**

**Zechariah 4:9 "The hands of Zerubbabel
Have laid the foundation of this temple;
His hands shall also finish it.
Then you will know
That the Lord of hosts has sent Me to you.**

**Luke 14:27-33 "And whoever does not bear his cross and come after Me cannot be My
disciple.
28 "For which of you, intending to build a tower, does not sit down first and count the cost,
whether he has enough to finish it--
29 "lest, after he has laid the foundation, and is not able to finish, all who see it begin to
mock him,
30 "saying, 'This man began to build and was not able to finish.'
31 "Or what king, going to make war against another king, does not sit down first and
consider whether he is able with ten thousand to meet him who comes against him with
twenty thousand?
32 "Or else, while the other is still a great way off, he sends a delegation and asks
conditions of peace.
33 "So likewise, whoever of you does not forsake all that he has cannot be My disciple.**

**John 4:34 Jesus said to them, "My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me, and to finish
His work.**

**John 5:36 "But I have a greater witness than John's; for the works which the Father has
given Me to finish--the very works that I do--bear witness of Me, that the Father has sent
Me.**

**John 17:4 "I have glorified You on the earth. I have finished the work which You have given
Me to do.**

**John 19:30 So when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "It is finished!" And
bowing His head, He gave up His spirit.**

**Acts 12:25 And Barnabas and Saul returned from Jerusalem when they had fulfilled [their]
ministry, and they also took with them John whose surname was Mark.**

**Acts 14:26 From there they sailed to Antioch, where they had been commended to the
grace of God for the work which they had completed.**

**Acts 20:24 "But none of these things move me; nor do I count my life dear to myself, so
that I may finish my race with joy, and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, to
testify to the gospel of the grace of God.**

**Romans 9:28 For He will finish the work and cut it short in righteousness,
Because the Lord will make a short work upon the earth."**

**2 Corinthians 8:11 but now you also must complete the doing of it; that as there was a
readiness to desire it, so there also may be a completion out of what you have.**

Philippians 1:6 being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ;

1 Thessalonians 5:24 He who calls you is faithful, who also will do it.

2 Timothy 4:7 I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith.

Hebrews 12:1-2 Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us,

2 looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of [our] faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
