

CONFESSIONS FOR HEALING

- 📖 He is the **Lord** that heals **me** (Exodus 15:26)
- 📖 He sent His **Word** and healed **me** (Psalm 107:20)
- 📖 He has restored health to me, and has healed **my** wounds (Jeremiah 30:17)
- 📖 I cried out to the **Lord** and He healed **me** (Psalm 30:2)
- 📖 He has taken sickness from the midst of **me** (Exodus 23:25)
- 📖 He has forgiven all **my** iniquities and has healed all **my** diseases (Psalm 103:3)
- 📖 With His stripes **I** am healed now (Isaiah 53:5)
- 📖 **Jesus** healed **all** who were oppressed of the devil, and **I'm** part of **all** (Acts 10:38)
- 📖 **Jesus** Himself took my infirmities and bare **my** sicknesses (Matthew 8:17)
- 📖 The same **Spirit** that raised **Christ** from the dead dwells in **me**, and that same **Spirit** quickens **my** mortal body now (Romans 8:11)
- 📖 **I've** been anointed with oil in the Name of the **Lord**, and the prayer of faith **has** saved **me**, and the Lord has raised **me** up (James 5:14,15)
- 📖 Believers' hands have been laid on **me**, and **I have** recovered (Mark 16:18)
- 📖 It is His will that I prosper and be in health, even as **my** soul prospers (3 John:2)
- 📖 By His stripes **I was** healed (1 Peter 2:24) I was healed about 2000 years ago so I am already healed!
- 📖 His **Word** is life and health to all **my** flesh (Proverbs 4:22)
- 📖 I am strong in the Lord and in the power of His Might (Ephesians 6:10)
- 📖 No evil shall befall **me**; nor shall any plague come near my dwelling (Psalm 91:10)
- 📖 **God** has girded **me** with strength (Psalm 18:39)
- 📖 The joy of the **Lord** is **my** strength (Nehemiah 8:10)
- 📖 As **my** days, so shall **my** strength be (Deuteronomy 33:25)
- 📖 I can do all things through **Christ** who strengthens me (Philippians 4:13)
- 📖 I take hold of **God's** strength (Isaiah 27:5)
- 📖 **God** is the strength of **my** heart (Psalm 73:26)
- 📖 No bone of **mine** shall be broken (John 19:36)
- 📖 **Jesus, my** Passover Lamb, has been sacrificed for **me**; therefore, all sickness and disease must pass over **me** (1 Corinthians 5:7)
- 📖 **God** is **my** strength. The **Lord** is the strength of **my** life (Psalm 118:17)
- 📖 I discern the **Lord's** body broken for **my** healing (1 Corinthians 11:29)
- 📖 I have the mind of **Christ**. **My** mind is renewed by the **Word of God** (1 Corinthians 2:16; Romans 12:2)
- 📖 I have the spirit of a sound mind (2 Timothy 1:7)
- 📖 **God** satisfies **my** mouth with good things so that **my** youth is renewed like the eagle's (Psalm 103:5)
- 📖 **My** eyes will not be dim, neither will **my** natural force be abated, for **God** has no respect of persons, and what He did for Moses, He'll do for **me**. And Moses was 120 when he died, and his eyes were not dim, neither was his natural force abated (Deuteronomy 34:7; Romans 2:11)
- 📖 As Jesus cursed the fig tree and it withered, **I** curse, in the name of Jesus, the disease or sickness, and it shall also wither (Matthew 21:19)
- 📖 **I am** redeemed of the **Lord** from sickness and disease and **I** say so (Psalm 107:2)
- 📖 📖 **Christ** has redeemed **me** from the curse of sickness; therefore, **I** forbid any sickness or disease to come upon **this** body in **Jesus'** name, and every sickness and every disease and every infirmity has to get out now, in the name of **Jesus**. Every tissue in **this** body and every organ and every part of **this** body functions perfectly in the way God created it to function; and I forbid this body to malfunction in any way in the name of **Jesus** (Galatians 3:13)
- 📖 I am healed, I am free, I am delivered. **Whom** the **Son** sets free is free indeed (John 8:36)
- 📖 Satan, **I'm God's** property and you cannot touch **me** or destroy **me**; for I have been delivered out of the power of darkness and translated into the kingdom of **God's** dear Son. Devil, I resist you in the name of **Jesus**, and all your spirits of infirmity, sickness and disease; and it is written, "Resist the devil and he will flee from **you**;" and it is also written that with His stripes I am healed. So **I** declare **I** am healed (1 Corinthians 6:19; Colossians 1:13; James 4:7; Isaiah 53:5)
