

Prayer Walking

Prayer: I Timothy 2:1-5

Walking: Joshua 1:3,4

What to pray over each house:

1. Speak peace (Luke 10:1-12)
2. Rebuke the devil (Ephesians 6:10-12/2 Corinthians 4:3-6)
 - a. Bind & loose (bind the devils over each home, loose those captive and bind them to the kingdom of God)
 - b. 2 Corinthians 10:3-6 – Pull down strong holds, imaginations, high things
 - c. Luke 10:17-20 – Use the name of Jesus with authority. Cast out devils
3. Detailed Prayer (Pray before starting prayer walking)

In the name of Jesus Christ, I bind my neighbors to Your will and purposes for their lives. I bind their minds to the mind of Christ that they will hear the very thoughts, intents, and purposes of His heart towards them. I bind my neighbor's feet to the paths You've ordained for them to walk in – paths leading right into Your arms. I bind their hands to the special work You've ordained for them to accomplish in the Kingdom. I bind my neighbors to the work of the Cross in their lives, for it is out of the crucifixion of self that Your forgiveness, love, mercy, power and authority will be able to flow through every area of their lives.

I bind my neighbors to the truth of the goodness of the Gospel of Jesus Christ, to the truth of Your Word. I loose all preconceived ideas they have about you, Lord. I loose all half-truths they have believed about You. I loose discouragement, deception, and denial from them.

I bind my neighbors to the sweetness of Your love, to the drawing and wooing of Your Holy Spirit. I bind my neighbors into Your care, and I loose the wrong thinking that has caused them to flee from being under the shadow of your wings. I bind them to the truth of Your grace and Your mercy. I loose guilt and fear from my neighbors – wrong ideas that they have done too many sinful things, that they have gone too far to be accepted and forgiven by You. I bind them to an understanding of the concept of grace – Your wonderful grace.

I loose all generational bondage's, religious bondages, fleshly bondages, and soul ties from my neighbors. Lord, in Jesus name, I cut, sever, slash, and break the bondages of the world from them. Move upon my neighbors by Your Holy Spirit, Lord and draw them to Yourself.
